CORN CASSEROLE



The class really enjoyed making and eating this recipe. We omitted the pepper and green onions.

Ingredients:

- 2 Eggs, beaten
- 1 Pkg.(10oz) Frozen Whole Kernel Corn
- 1/2 C Sour Cream
- 1 Can (15oz) Cream-Style Corn
- 1 Pkg. (8.5oz) Corn Muffin Mix
- 1/8 t Black Pepper
- 1 Pkg. (8oz) Kraft Shredded Three Cheese
- Blend, divided
- 4 Slices Cooked Bacon, Crumbled
- 4 Green Onions, sliced

Instructions:

- · Heat oven to 375°F.
- Combine first 6 ingredients in a medium bowl. Stir in 1/2 cup cheese. Pour into 2-qt casserole sprayed with cooking spray.
- Bake 40 min. Meanwhile, combine remaining cheese, onions, and bacon.
- Top casserole with cheese mixture; bake
 15 min. or until lightly browned.
