PRESCHOOL & ELEMENTARY **WORK HAND IN HAND**

Research has found that kids that take part in early education programs are more likely to succeed as adults, according to an analysis by University of Chicago economists. Decades later, preschool attendees got better grades; were more likely to graduate high school and get married; and less likely to get arrested multiple times or become dependent on welfare.

But what's really surprising is why. Although kids who attend preschool see an initial boost in IQ scores, that advantage dissipates by the second grade. More lasting are the non-cognitive skills and self-control the 3 and 4 year olds develop through early socialization. "Perseverance, dependability, and consistency,: researchers say, "are the most important predictors of grades in school." The economists have calculated that every dollar invested in preschool for at-risk children brings an \$8 to \$9 return to society. Better yet, in a Catholic preschool and school, we are preparing young people to develop strong moral and Catholic attitudes toward society in general. We are most assuredly blessed with a school that provides this special service to children from ages 2.5 to 13.

TATOR TOT BREAKFAST BAKE

INGREDIENTS:

4 SLICES BACON (COOKED & CRUMBLED)

1 90Z BAG OF PRE-COOKED SAUSAGE CRUMBLES

2 C CHEDDAR CHEESE SHREDDED, DIVIDED

2 C MILK

3 LARGE EGGS

1/2 TSP BLACK PEPPER

1/2 TSP ONION POWDER

PINCH OF SALT

2 LBS FROZEN TATOR TOTS





INSTRUCTIONS:

- PREHEAT OVEN TO 375º
- IN A 9 X 13 BAKING PAN SPRAYED WITH PAM, LAYER SAUSAGE CRUMBLES AND 1 CUP SHREDDED CHEESE.
- IN A LARGE BOWL, WHISK TOGETHER THE MILK, EGGS, PEPPER, ONION POWDER, AND SALT. POUR OVER SAUSAGE AND CHEESE IN BAKING DISH. LAYER TOP WITH FROZEN TATER TOTS
- PLACE UNCOVERED CASSEROLE IN OVEN AND BAKE FOR 50
 MINUTES
- INCREASE THE TEMP TO 400°, SPRINKLE THE TOP WITH REMAINING CHEESE AND BACON CRUMBLES. BAKE AN ADDITIONAL 10-15 MINUTES, UNTIL BUBBLING AND GOLDEN BROWN.
- LET COOL AND ENJOY!
